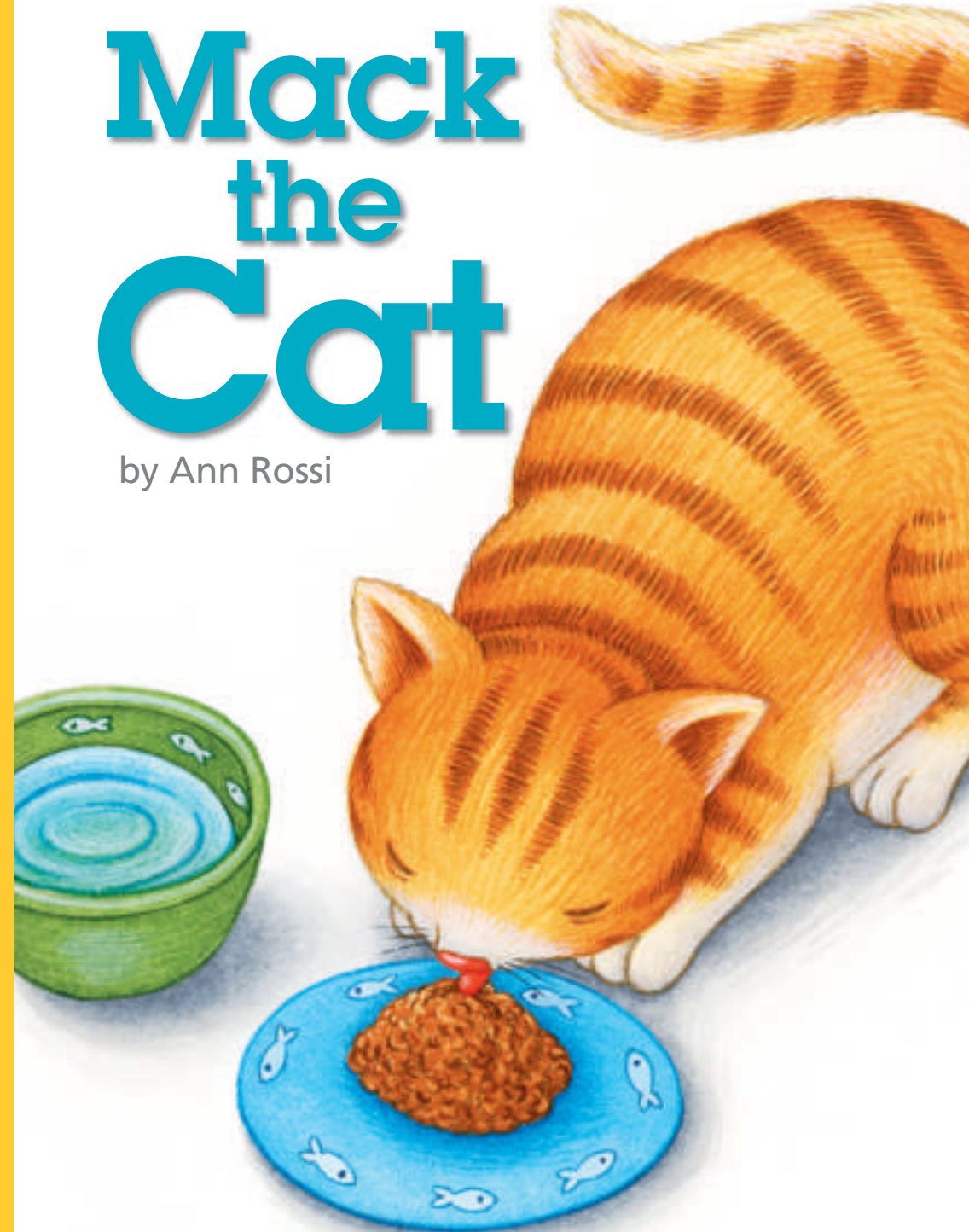

Read Together

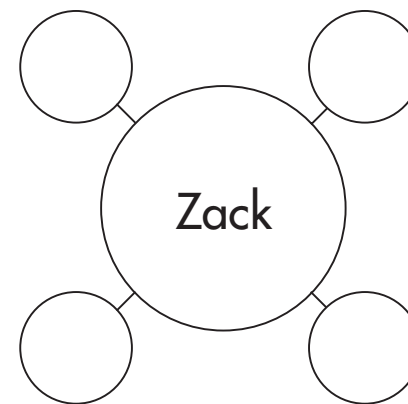
Cats need food and water each day. Someone should brush their fur. Brushing their fur helps cats stay clean. It is good for cats to play and nap. A cat can be a loving pet.
