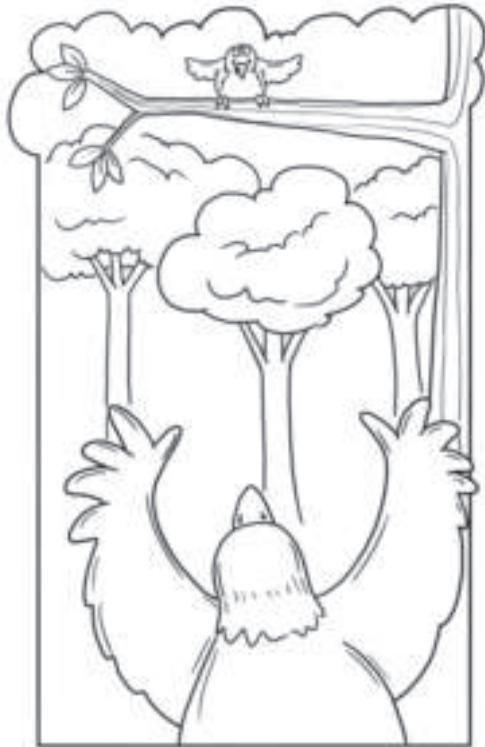

"These wings will fly."

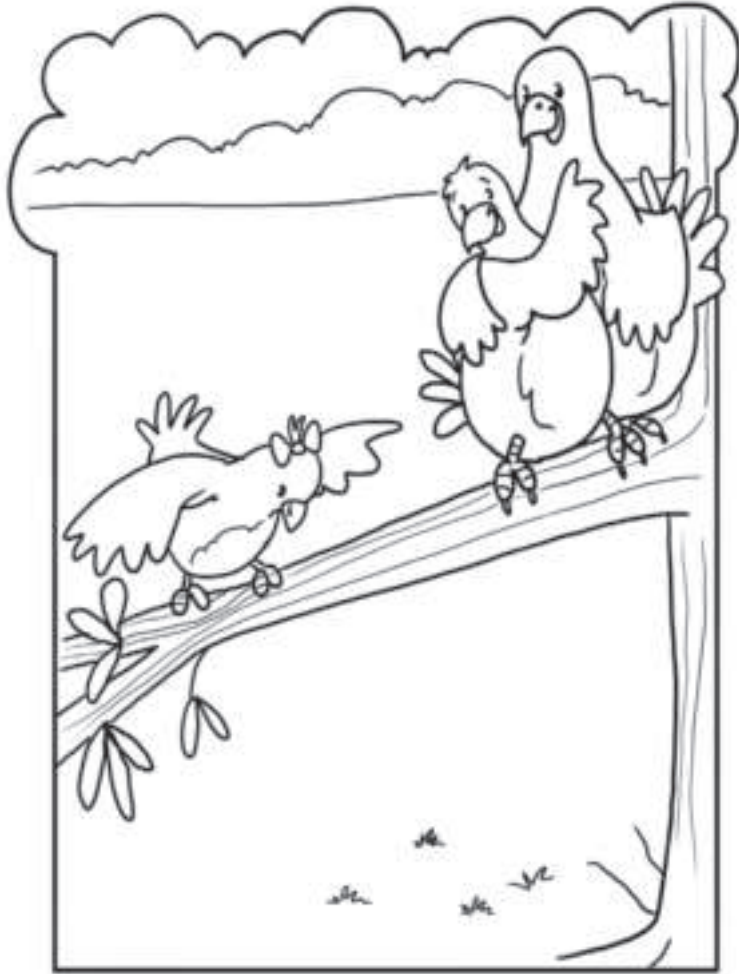


Dad woke Sam the next day.

You can fly!"

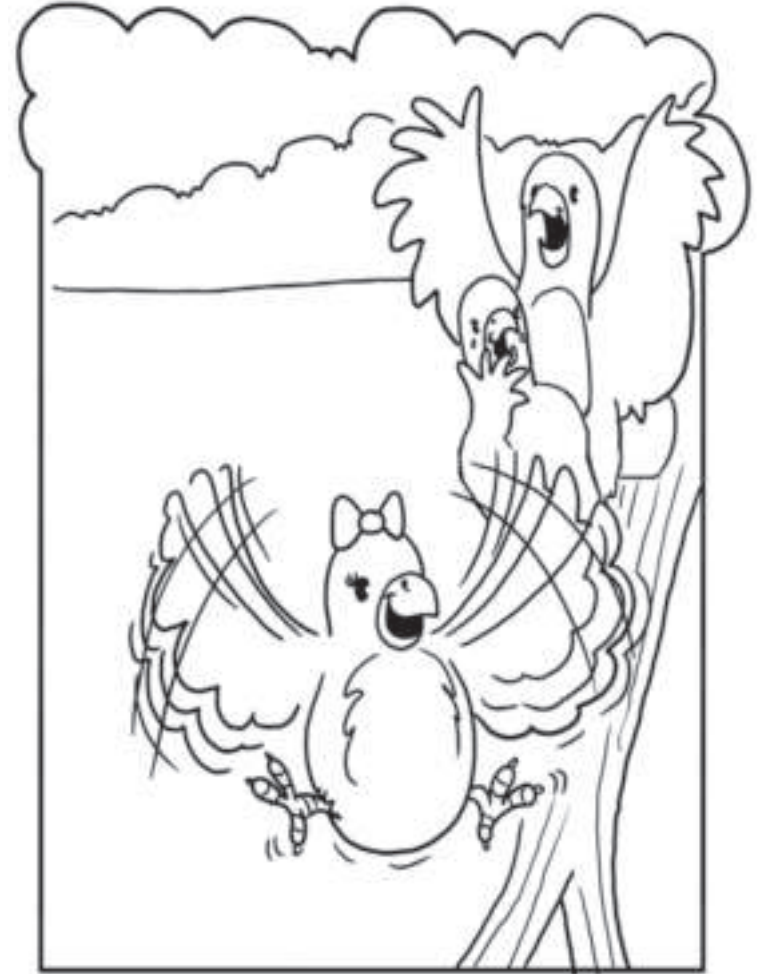


Sam hopped in her nest.

"I hope I can fly!"



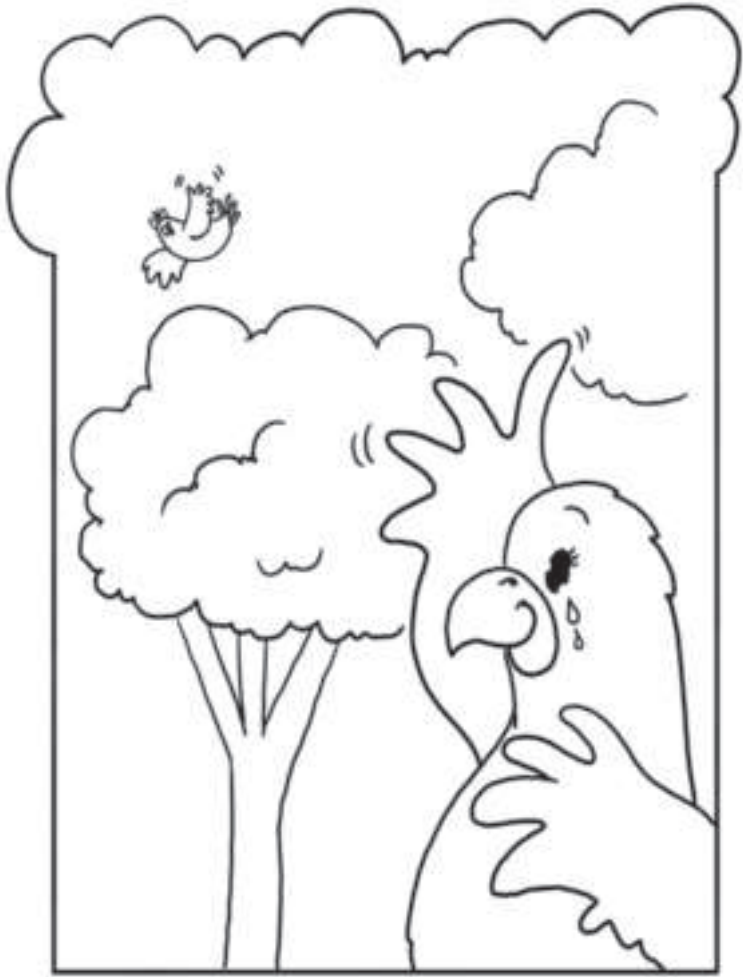


Mom came with Sam and Dad.
