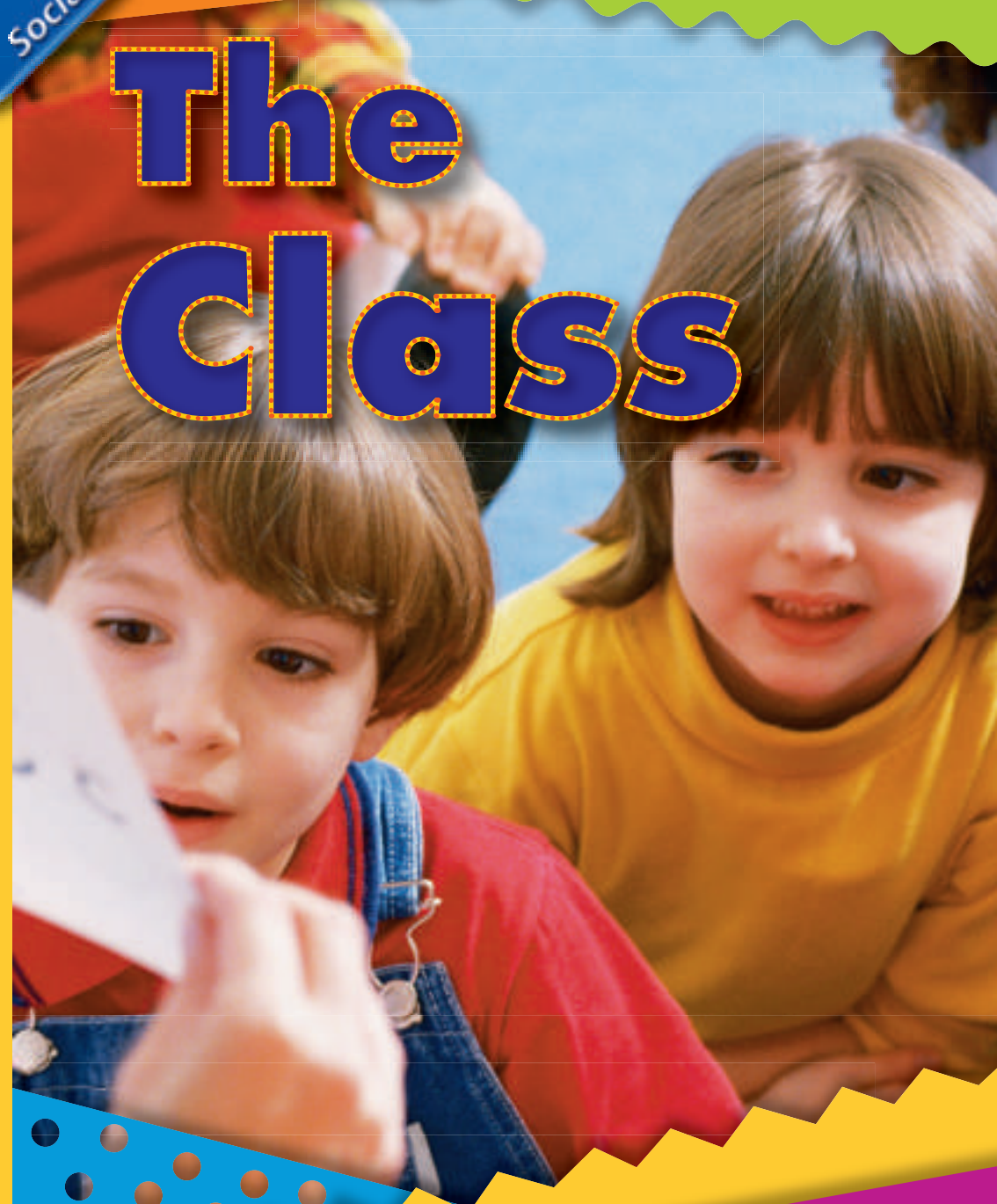

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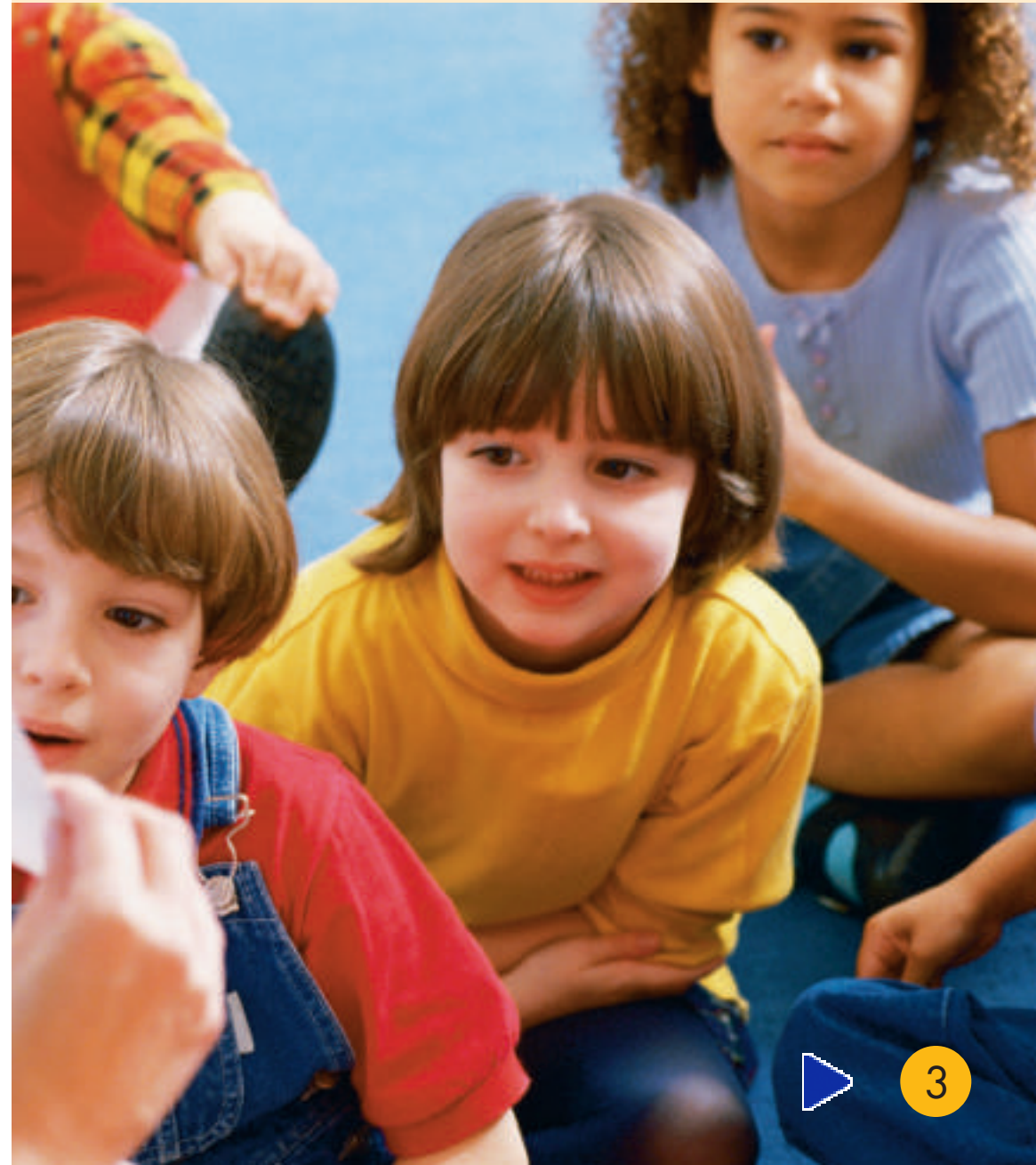




Here is a class.

They draw on paper.

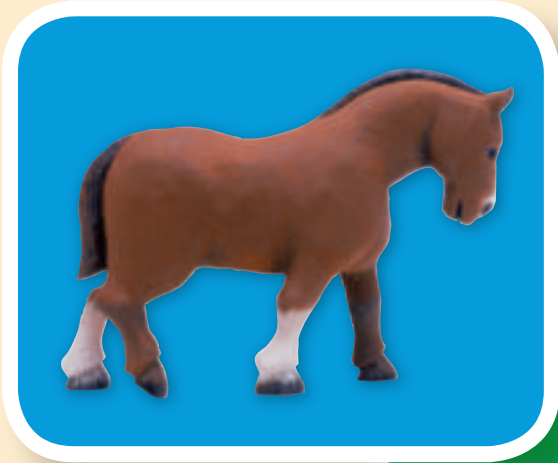


The class has jobs.
