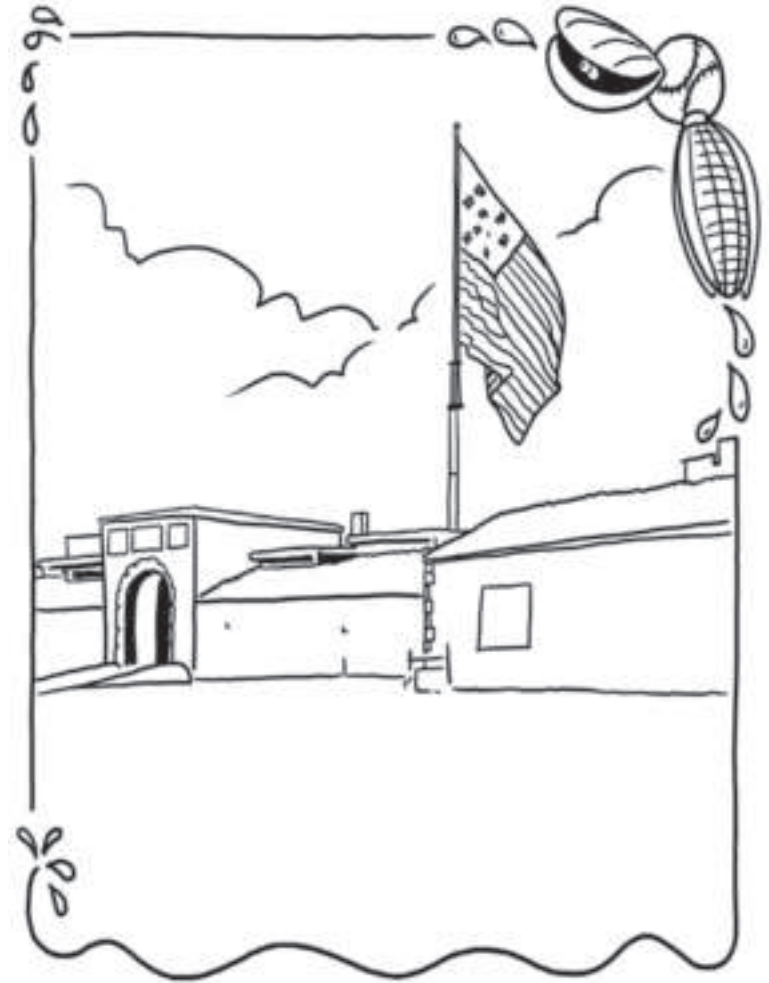
 I wore my cap.

I see ships in the water.

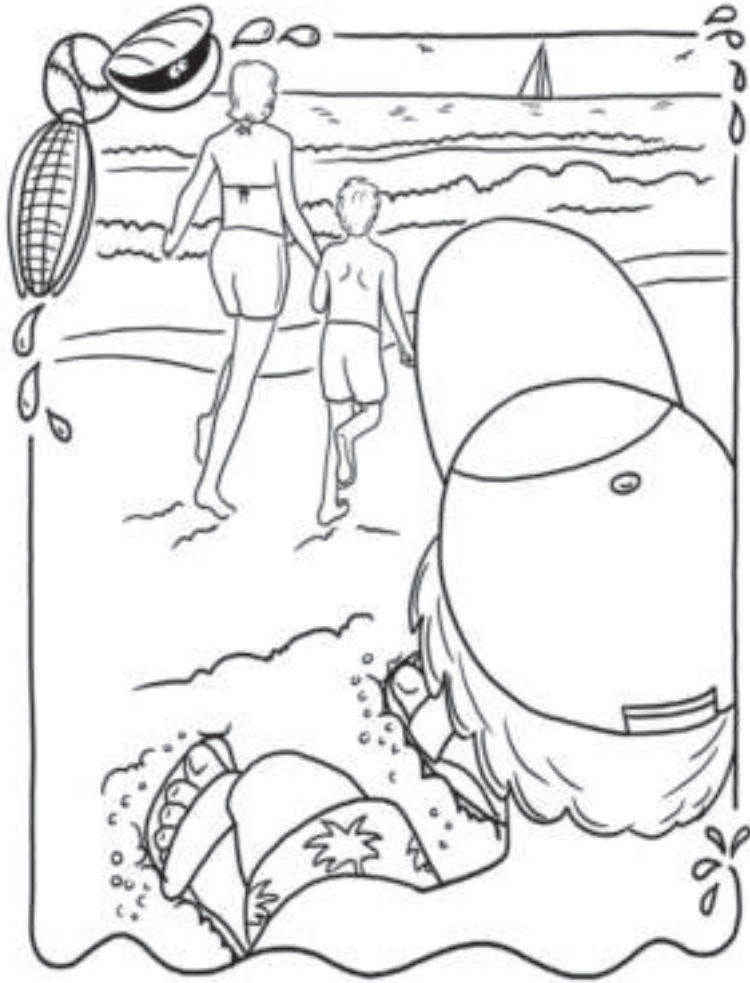


Dad and I see a ball game.
